## Art Cart Facilitator

ATT is looking for a creative facilitator to run arts and craft activity sessions for children and families in community spaces in Ellesmere Port.

Thanks to support from Awards for All, a specially made mobile 'art cart' will be designed and made to be used to offer light touch craft sessions for children and local families.

Our aim is to engage with local audiences and build awareness of the wide range of performances and events available from ATT.

Specifically, the Art Cart sessions would take place at our monthly Family Film Clubs on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of every month, throughout the October 2018 half term week at our Ellesmere Port Family Festival, at ATT shows (*Adrift* and *Beauty and the Beast*) and at visiting shows taking place at Whitby Hall throughout the autumn and spring.

We are looking to appoint an artist from the North West, who is proficient in **visual arts, drama and/or associated activities**.

### Key Dates

- **1<sup>st</sup> October 2018:** *Adrift* preview, Ellesmere Port Civic Hall, evening session
- **September 2018–June 2019:** Monthly Family Film Club — the third Saturday of every month, afternoon session
- **28th October–3rd November 2018:** Ellesmere Port Family Festival — 4 hour session each day
- **10th January 2019** (evening), **12th & 13th January** (daytime): *Beauty and the Beast*

The fee will be £200 per day/ £100 per half day/ £25 per hour

- High quality artistic practice in the fields of visual arts, drama or associated activities
- Strong planning, communication and organisational skills
- Ability to exercise initiative, work with minimum supervision and take personal responsibility
- Ability to work well in a diverse team and cooperate with others
- Excellent timekeeping skills, conscientious and punctual
- An understanding of equal opportunities practices and interest in enabling more people to experience the arts
- Experience of working in a creative environment or arts venue
